- Be able to participate in a week-long Student Leaders Summit in Washington, DC (July 8- July 13, 2018). All expenses are paid. This week will be part of their 8-week experience.
- Be a student in good standing at your school.
- Obtain a letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator.
