- PCS is a small school community where students are well-known and teachers are accessible.
- We value diversity as a critical part of our school culture. We welcome all applicants from Princeton.
- Seats are available at all grade levels, but kindergarten and grade 3 are the main points of entry.
- Students are admitted to Charter based on a random lottery.
- Students who qualify for a weighted lottery based on family income will have their names entered into the lottery twice.

Some key attributes of PCS:

- Small school community where students are well-known and teachers are accessible.
- Strong record of excellent academic achievement.
 - Low teacher-student ratios in all English and math classes
 - World language (Spanish and French) begins in Kindergarten
 - Daily world language starting in first grade
 - Strong support for students who learn differently or have special needs
 - Science taught by a specialized science teacher starting in kindergarten
- Two comprehensive parent/teacher conferences per year where parents meet with teachers for each academic subject as well as specials.
- An aftercare program run by PCS teachers focused on academic enrichment and play.

We educate the whole child through our arts program which includes music, art, and drama. In addition we value participation in our sports programs where no student is cut from any team. We offer a full array of school clubs including chess, service corps, Operation Smile, MathCounts, Science Bowl, robotics, school newspaper, school musical, orchestra, Jazz ensemble, chorus, art club, WordMasters Club, etc.
